

## **Child Asset Evaluation Results – Bravo Waterbury! Sept. 2012- May 2013**

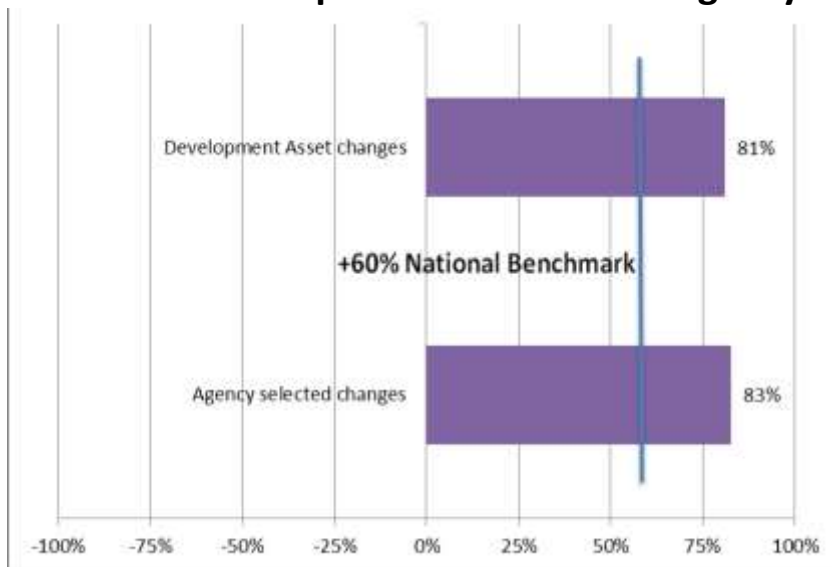
Bravo Waterbury is a child and youth development program based on the Venezuelan el Sistema framework where children and youth learn resilience, dedication, respect and other social skills by participation in music education and especially in participating in an orchestra. The Leever Foundation funds Bravo! Waterbury in a partnership with the Children’s Community School and the Waterbury Symphony Orchestra. Bridge to Success received a grant to develop a child-focused survey (as the DAP was not age appropriate for this program) for Bravo! Waterbury, and expand to the entire Waterbury community.

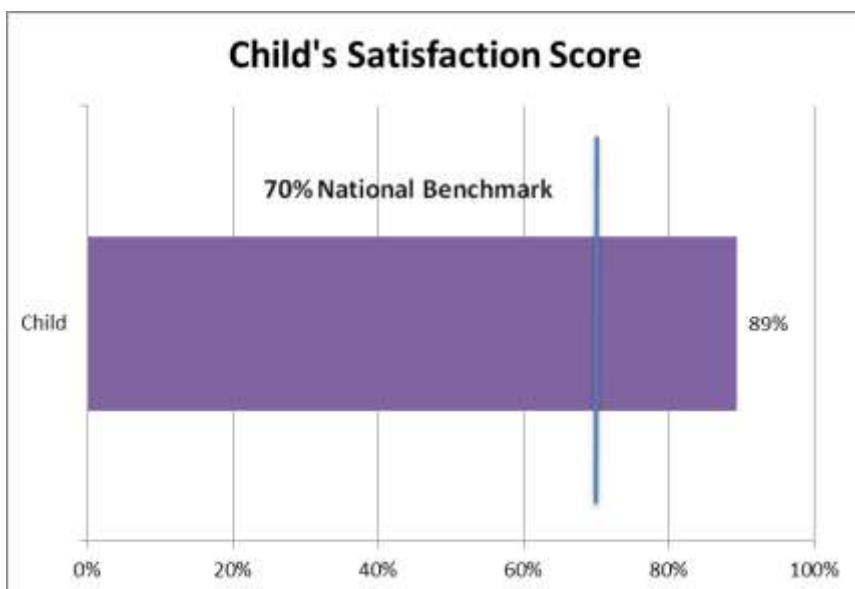
### **Child Developmental Assets and Agency Selected Change Scores**

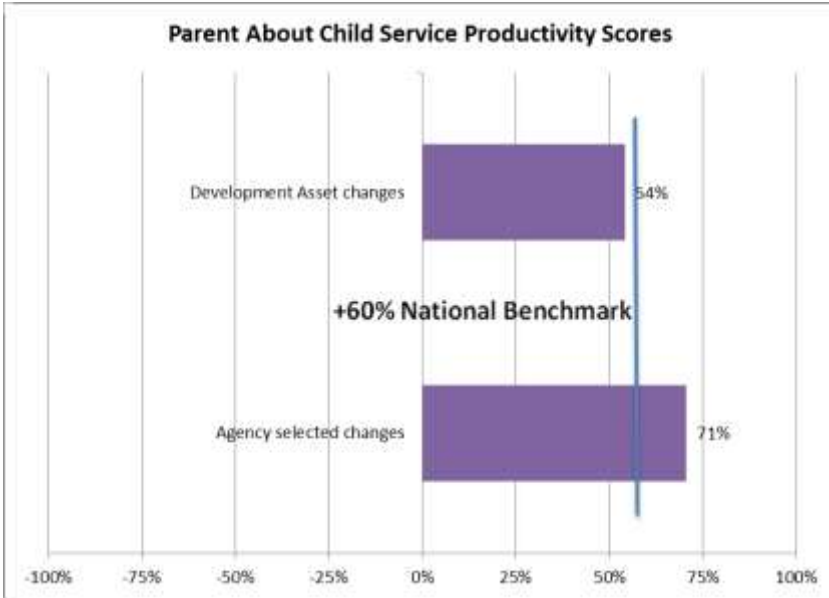
### **Child's Satisfaction Score**



***Bravo! Waterbury results show significantly higher Child Satisfaction scores when compared to over 700,000 evaluations done nationwide***

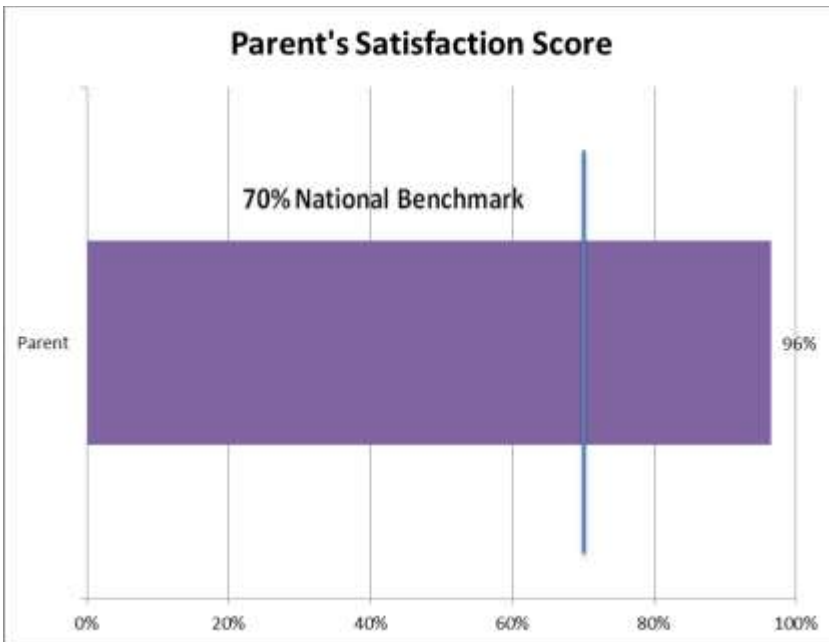

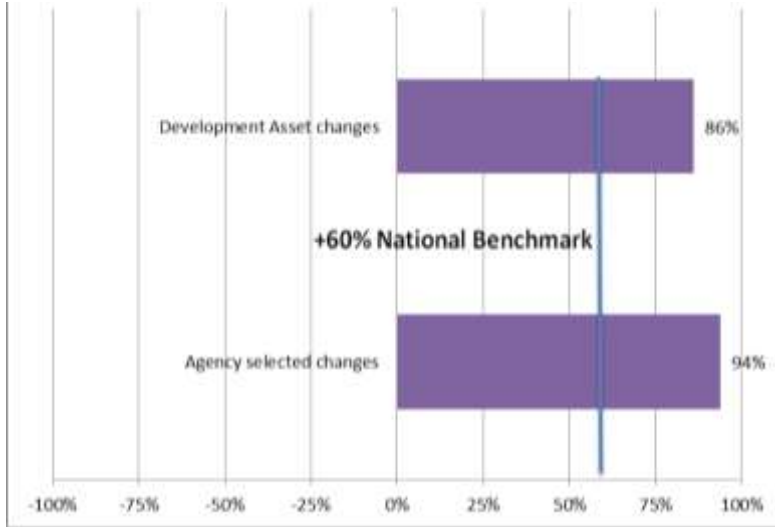
